Main Scripture Reference

Psalm 24 – The earth is the Lord's and the fulness thereof; the world and they that dwell therein.

Mark 10:27, Luke 18:27 – With men it is impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible.

Mark 14:36 – Father, all things are possible to Thee (Jesus in the garden before His crucifixion – asking for the cup to be taken away, but submitting to the will of the Father)

1 Chronicles 29:11 – Thine, O Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty; for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom O Lord, and thou art exalted as head above all.

Demonstration of God's/Jesus Sovereignty

- 1) Rebuked the wind and calmed the sea
- 2) He is the only one who can reveal the Father to you
- 3) You must trust Him alone for salvation
- 4) Ascended All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Jesus
